

JURY NOTICE 01

RC44 CLASS POLICY ON REDRESS

When the Jury decides that a boat is entitled to redress, the following policy on redress, as approved by the RC 44 class, shall be followed;

MATCH RACING

In the event of serious damage and the damaged boat, through no fault of her own, can not continue racing or the class confirms after racing that the performance of the boat was seriously affected and the penalised boat was not black flagged, the Jury will disqualify the penalised boat and award that match to the damaged boat.

The Jury will not give redress for any subsequent matches.

FLEET RACING

In the event of serious damage and the damaged boat, through no fault of her own, can not continue racing or the class confirms after racing that the performance of the boat was seriously affected, the redress will be points equal to 50% (rounded down to a whole number) of the number of boats entered in that event.

The Jury will give the same redress for any subsequent races the technical delegate determines the boat will not be able to sail.
